NOTICE TO RESIDENTS & BUSINESSES

REHABILITATION OF LOCALIZED STREETS, PHASE 11C HAWAII KAI & KAMEHAME, OAHU, HAWAII

Road and Highway Builders, LLC has been contracted by the City & County of Honolulu to perform the aforementioned project. The project includes cold planing, reconstruction and resurfacing of the asphalt roadway. Pre-paving activities include reconstruction of identified curbs, gutters and driveways; installation of new storm drain inlets; tree trimming, root pruning or removal as identified and coordinated by the City's project arborist. Post-paving activities include the adjustment of utilities to finish grade; installation of permanent pavement markings and replacement of vehicle loop sensors.

The construction work is scheduled to begin December 8, 2014 with a contract duration of 360 consecutive calendar days. Work hours will be from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday to Friday; Residents and businesses are advised that on-street parking will be prohibited at times. "NO PARKING TOW AWAY" signs will be posted a minimum of 24 hours in advance to warn you of the impending work. Please observe the dates and times posted on these signs; illegally parked vehicles will be towed at the owner's expense. Observe and obey all traffic controls, posted signs and special duty officers. Drivers should avoid unnecessary travel through the area or consider alternate routes when possible; otherwise anticipate delays and allow extra travel time.

The Contractor is responsible to coordinate and provide for local traffic, residents, businesses deliveries, mail and trash collection, bus and emergency services during construction. Every effort will be made to complete this essential work as quickly as possible. The asphalt material is hot, black and tacky; walking or driving across the pavement in an uncured state could cause serious burns, tracking into your driveways and house, or stick to your pets. Therefore for your safety and protection from these hazards, we ask for your assistance and cooperation as we may delay your ingress and egress into your driveway during working hours.

We will make every effort to minimize your inconvenience and would greatly appreciate your assistance, support, patience and cooperation.
